Know about the Zones

With Effect from 4th May, 2020



Green Zones

Districts with zero confirmed cases till date or no confirmed case in the last 21 days



Red Zones

Districts identified taking into account the total number of active cases, doubling rate of confirmed cases, extent of testing & surveillance feedback from the districts



Orange Zones

Those districts, which are neither defined as Red nor Green, shall be classified as Orange zones



Containment Zones

Containment Zones to be identified by State/UTs and District administration based on the guidelines of Health Ministry

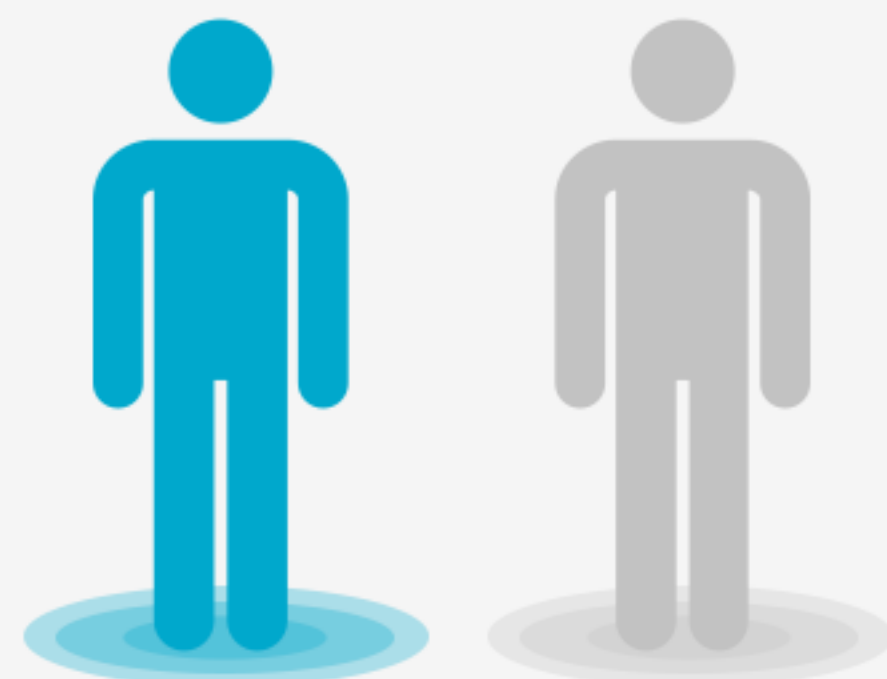


*Classification of districts into Zones will be shared by Health Ministry on a weekly basis or as required

Containment Zone



Information



Containment Zones to be identified by State/UTs and District administration based on the guidelines of Health Ministry



Local Authority to ensure 100% coverage of Aarogya Setu app among the residents



The zone to have intensified surveillance protocols with contact tracing, house to house surveillance, home/institutional quarantining of persons



Strict perimeter control to be ensured. Movement only for medical emergencies & supply of essential goods & services

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Activities to Remain Prohibited Nationally

With Effect from 4th May, 2020



Red Zone



Orange Zone



Green Zone



Travel by air, rail, metro & inter-state movement by road



Schools, Colleges & other educational training / coaching institutions



Hospitality services including hotels & restaurants



Places of large public gatherings such as cinema halls, malls, gyms, sports complexes, etc



Social, political, cultural & other kinds of gatherings; religious places



Movement of persons by air, rail & road allowed only for select purposes

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Safety Measures Applicable Nationally

With Effect from 4th May, 2020



Red Zone



Orange Zone



Green Zone



Movement of individuals for all non-essential activities strictly prohibited between 7 pm to 7 am



Local authorities to issue orders and ensure strict compliance



Persons above 65 years, those with comorbidities, pregnant women & children below 10 years to stay home except for essentials & health purposes



OPDs & Medical clinics to operate in Red, Orange & Green Zones with social distancing norms & other safety precautions

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Activities Prohibited in Red Zones (1/5)

With Effect from 4th May, 2020

Activities prohibited across the country

Additional activities not permitted



Plying of Cycle Rickshaws and Auto Rickshaws



Running of taxis and cab aggregators



Intra-district & Inter-district plying of buses



Malls, Barber Shops, Spas and Salons



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Movement of Persons Allowed in Red Zones (2/5)



With Effect from 4th May, 2020

*Not allowed in Containment Areas

Red Zone



Allowed

Movement of individuals & vehicles allowed only
for permitted activities



A maximum of 2 persons (besides the driver)
in 4-wheeler vehicles



No pillion rider in the case of 2-wheelers



All persons such as healthcare workers,
govt. officers etc as exempted by authorities

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Industrial Establishments Allowed in Red Zones (Urban Areas) (3/5)

With Effect from 4th May, 2020

*Not applicable in Containment Zones



Red Zone



Allowed



SEZs, Export Oriented Units, industrial estates & industrial townships



Other industrial activities like manufacturing units of essential goods, including drugs, medical devices, their raw material, etc



Production units which require continuous process and their supply chain



Manufacturing of IT hardware; Jute industry; manufacturing units of packaging material



Construction activities in-situ construction; construction of renewable energy projects

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Shops Allowed in Red Zones (4/5)

With Effect from 4th May, 2020

*Not allowed in Containment Areas



Red Zone



Allowed



E-Commerce services to be permitted only for essential goods for both rural & urban areas

Urban areas



All standalone shops, neighborhood shops & shops in residential complexes for essential & non-essential to remain open



In Markets & Market complexes, only shops selling essential goods permitted

Rural areas



All shops except in malls to remain open without any distinction of essential and non-essentials

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Offices Allowed with Restrictions in Red Zones (5/5)

With Effect from 4th May, 2020

*Not applicable in Containment Zones

Allowed



Private offices to operate with upto 33% strength & remaining persons working from home



All Govt offices to function with senior officers of the level of Deputy Secretary & above at full strength, remaining staff upto 33%



Defense & Security services, Health & Family Welfare, Police, Fire & Emergency Services, NIC, Customs, etc. to function without any restriction

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Activities Allowed in Orange Zone

With Effect from 4th May, 2020

*Not allowed in Containment Areas

Allowed

All activities are permitted in the zone except



Activities prohibited across the country



Inter and Intra district plying of buses



Following permitted with restrictions



Taxi and Cab aggregators permitted with 1 driver and 2 passengers only



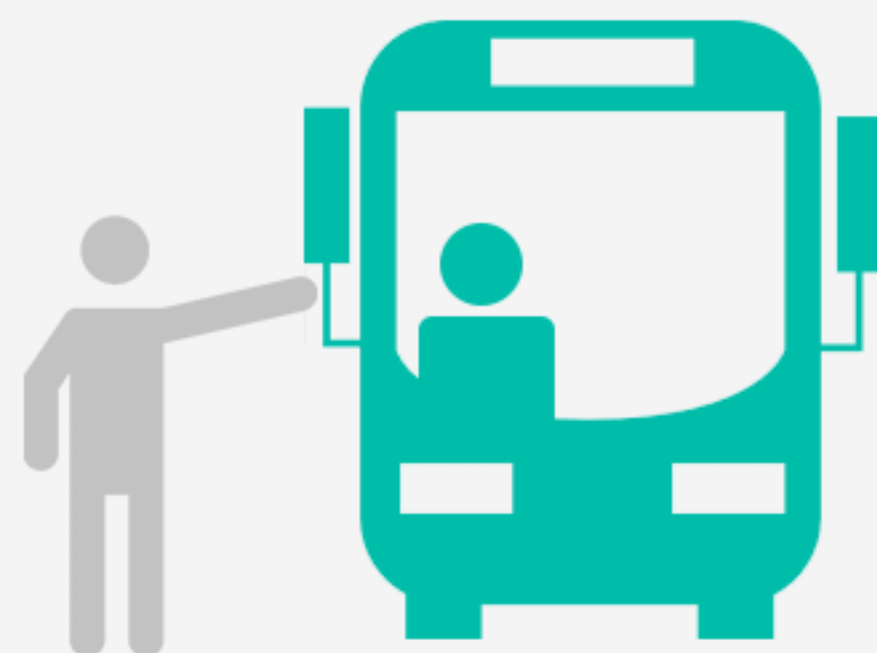
Four wheeler vehicles to have maximum 2 passengers besides the driver & pillion riding allowed on two-wheelers



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Activities Allowed in Green Zones

With Effect from 4th May, 2020



Green Zone



Allowed



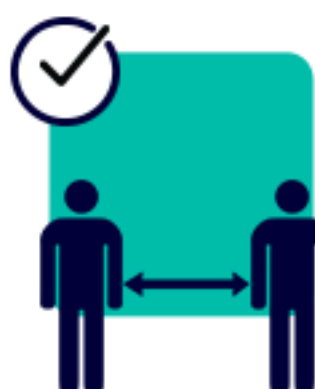
Districts with zero confirmed cases till date or no confirmed case in the last 21 days



All activities permitted except those which are prohibited throughout the country



Buses to operate with upto 50% seating capacity;
Bus Depots to operate with upto 50% capacity



Social Distancing norms and other safety precautions measures to be followed



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Movement of Cargo Allowed

With Effect from 4th May, 2020

*Not allowed in Containment Areas



Red Zone



Orange Zone



Green Zone



All goods traffic is to be permitted



No State/UTs to stop movement of cargo for cross land-border trade under Treaties with neighbouring countries



No separate pass of any sort needed for such movement, which is essential for maintaining supply chain of goods





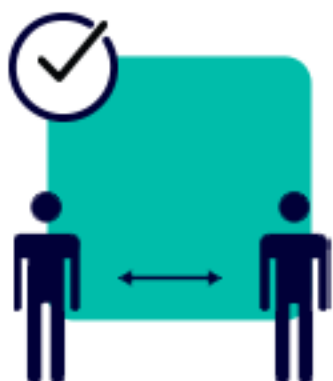
LOCKDOWN **3.0**

National Directives for PUBLIC PLACES (1/2)

With Effect from 4th May, 2020



Wearing of face cover is compulsory



Incharges of public places to ensure social distancing as per Health Ministry guidelines



No organization to allow gathering of 5 or more persons



Marriage related gatherings to ensure social distancing & no. of guests not to exceed 50





LOCKDOWN **3.0**

National Directives for PUBLIC PLACES (2/2)

With Effect from 4th May, 2020



Funeral related gatherings to ensure social distancing & not to exceed 20 persons



Spitting in public places punishable with fine



Consumption of liquor, paan, gutka, tobacco etc. in public places prohibited



Shops selling liquor, paan, tobacco etc. to ensure a min. 6 feet social distancing (Do Gaz Doori) & max. of 5 persons at a time





LOCKDOWN **3.0**

National Directives for **WORKPLACES** (1/3)

With Effect from 4th May, 2020



Wearing of face cover compulsory & adequate stock to be made available



All persons in-charge to ensure social distancing as per Ministry of Health guidelines both within the workplaces & in company transport



Ensure social distancing at workplaces through adequate gaps between shifts, staggering lunch breaks of staff etc.



Thermal scanning, hand wash & sanitizer to be made available at all entry, exit points and common areas

LOCKDOWN **3.0**

National Directives for **WORKPLACES** (2/3)



With Effect from 4th May, 2020



Frequent sanitization of workplace, common facilities & all points of human contact to be ensured



Persons above 65 years, persons with co-morbidities, pregnant women & children below 10 years to stay at home except for essential needs



Use of Arogya Setu app mandatory for all employees, both private and public; Head of Organizations to ensure 100% coverage of this app



Large physical meetings to be avoided; Intensive communication & training on good hygiene practices to be taken up

LOCKDOWN **3.0**

National Directives for **WORKPLACES** (3/3)



With Effect from 4th May, 2020



Nearby Hospitals/clinics authorized to treat COVID-19 patients to be identified & listed at workplace



Employees showing any symptom of COVID-19 to be immediately sent for check up



Quarantine areas to be earmarked for isolating employees showing symptoms till they are safely moved to medical facilities



Arrangements for transport facilities to be ensured with social distancing as required
