Oxygen on Wheels: 289 Oxygen Express trains with 1162 loaded tankers has transported 19,408 tonnes of LMO* across the country till date



Zonal Railways & workshops converted 5,601 ICF coaches to isolation coaches so as to create additional capacity to deal with the pandemic



86 Health facilities set up providing Covid treatment in Railways equipped with 6972 Covid beds, 296 invasive ventilators, 449 non invasive ventilators, 4600 Oxygen beds, 8969 oxygen cylinders, & 576 ICU beds

More than 5.5 lakhs PPE were manufactured for frontline railway staff treating patients with COVID-19



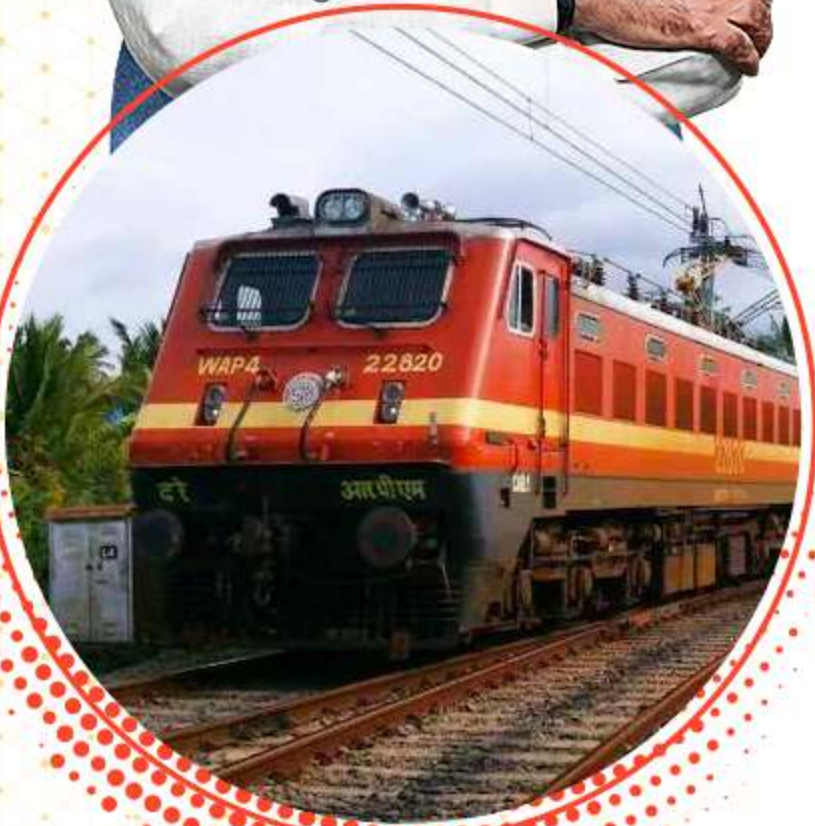
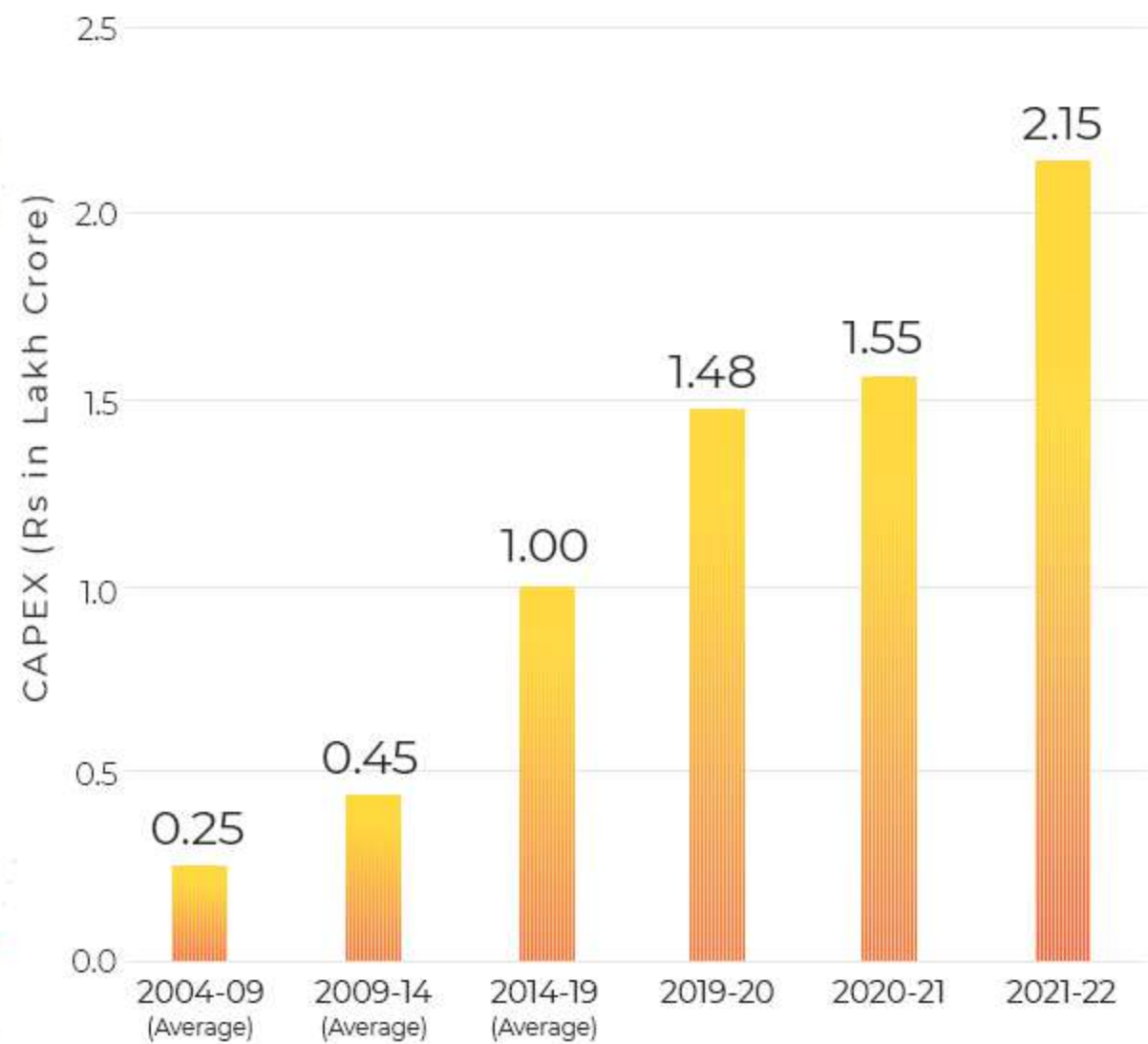

Provision of Wi-Fi facility at Railway Stations: planned to provide Wi-Fi facility at all the stations; provided at 6000 stations (as on 23.05.2021)

Best-Ever Loading Performance



Highest ever freight loading in a year: loaded 1233 MT during 2020-21 compared to 1210 MT during 2019-20



Freight Revenue: ₹1,17,199 crore during 2020-21 compared to ₹1,13,481 crore during 2019-20 (3.28% higher)



Introduction of Kisan Rail for carrying Agricultural produce to all parts of the country



Increase in freight train speed to about 45 kmph from around 22-24 kmph earlier resulting in additional line capacity & timely delivery of goods

*Expanding Connectivity
with Railway Electrification*



Despite COVID-19, highest-ever electrification of sections covering 6,015 Route Kilometer (RKM) in a single year achieved during 2020-21, surpassing the previous highest of 5,276 RKM achieved in 2018-19

- Total BG routes of 10,364 RKM commissioned during May-19 to March-21



End-to-end connectivity provided on many important routes by electrification of missing links along with first time connectivity to the North-East region
